How to fold milk cartons

1. Ease the straw out
2. Put the sharp end in the top of the carton
3. Drink it dry
4. Take out the straw
5. Fold the sides up
6. Make it flat and the bottom bit should fold up on the front
7. Fold the sides to the back and make sure that it covers the hole that you put the straw into
8. Fold it over and put it through the end bit folded up
9. Slip the straw through the middle of the carton
10. Send it back in the blue bin

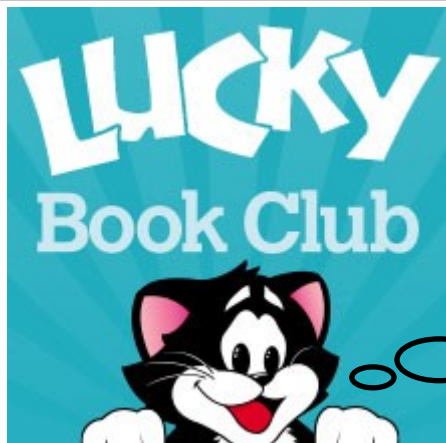
