Introducing—Anna Monrad

Anna is a Teacher Aide who has worked in the school for many years. During this time Anna has completed qualifications in teacher aide work and extra qualifications in literacy. She has worked closely with the Speech Language Specialist over a number of years and has become recognised by them as being very skilled in supporting students with speech problems and oral language.

Anna takes a range of groups and individual students in the school. In the junior classes she focuses on oral language groups and supporting students having difficulty with reading. This term she will be trialling a new writing programme with groups of students from each class in the senior school. She is also skilled in programmes including Quick 60, Repeated Reading, Rainbow Reading etc.

Anna also works very closely with the Resource Teachers Learning and Behaviour and the Resource Teacher for Literacy who are based in our school. Anna and the teachers often discuss students needs with these specialists so that Anna and the teacher can use the latest research. If required they will refer students to these services.

Anna works very closely with the teachers and together they plan the best programme for each student.
