Jenny Donald is our Information Technology administrator. She helps to keep the school network system and all the laptops, workstations, i-pads printers, photocopiers and any other IT up and running. We have a huge number of devices in the school and looking after them is too much work for teachers. A modern school is now unable to run without laptops and internet connection for learning and administration. Nearly all teacher resources are now on the net, most correspondence is e-mail and e-files rather than paper files record everything. It is a very complex system and when everything is going well its great, when its not its tears of frustration! Jenny has had extensive training in school systems over the years she has been with the school.

It is a very stressful job dealing with all the complexities of IT and why they will not do as they are told, as well as dealing with the frustrated staff who are having problems. Jenny also oversees the safety of the network. She can track every site the student has gone on the internet, as well as when and where they were. This makes for some uncomfortable surprise conversations for the student but luckily this is a very rare occurrence. Probably because they know Jenny will be asking them questions!
