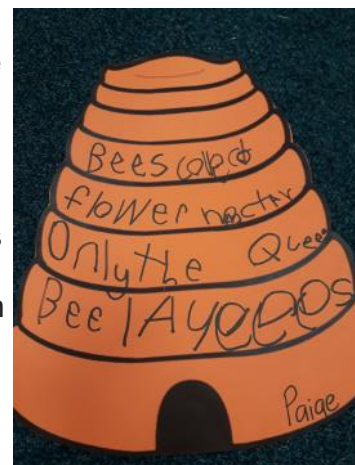
Room 9 have been learning about Bees. They have learnt about the life cycle and the work that bees do.

Serves approx. 12



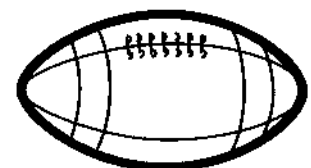
