Yesterday Lindsay was showing us how much sugar was in the drinks. There was lots in Coke.

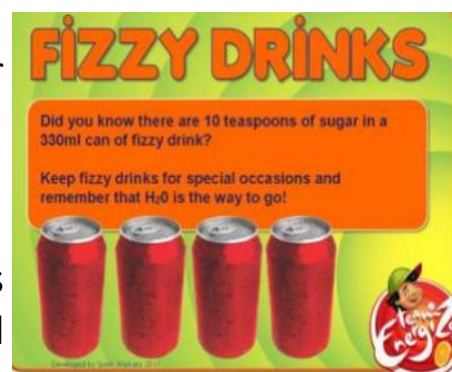


