**As part of their Anzac studies, Room 4 students composed some poignant “Letters to Home”.**

25th April 1915

Dear Mum and Dad,

Today we landed in Gallipoli and thankfully I made it through the day.....Just.

As we sailed closer to the shore all I could think about was that I might die. All around us we could see dead bodies, and the enemy racing towards us, loaded with weapons. The smell of gunpowder filled my nostrils and the sound of bombs filled my ears. By this time I was definitely wanting to come home. I was terrified.

The waves were picking up all the blood along the shore and the blue sea was no longer blue, but stained blood red.

As for my friend Hayley, I don't think she will be seeing another day. She got shot in the arms and legs multiple times and as I'm writing this she is in with the nurses getting who knows what done to her. Mikayla is lying next to me with a bandaged arm. She got shot in her arm but she's doing okay now. Thankfully it was her left arm so she can still write to her family.

Anyway, I hope to see you guys again soon.

April 25th 1915

Dear Mum,

I've made it through the day, just. I feel as if I'm loosing it!

Ashley, she's falling apart, literally. She got bombed and her right leg is badly injured. She is lucky not to be dead. On the other hand, Mikayla aint coming home ever. She had been shooting the Turks and as she looked away "Pew Pew" in the guts. Me, I'm fine, no injuries yet.

I will write everyday as long as I am able. I love you and I miss you, Dad, Kylie and Nathan a lot. Bye for now.
