

#### SCHOOL BUILDING RENOVATIONS

Most of you will be aware that the renovations of many of the spaces in the school has commenced.

Being refurbished are:

- The old IT Suite is becoming an inquiry centre for IT and Technology.
- The Garden Room is becoming a "Makerspace" for art, science and technology (with a green screen for video)
- The Hall will have all flooring replaced.
- Room 10 toilets and foyer.
- Room 4-7 will have a covered verandah built along the northern wall with the windows changed to large opening doors. This will enable the students to have a larger learning area all year round and reduce heat in the summer.

The work will finish mid May so until then we will have to work around the noise and make many shifts of resources and classrooms. The results however will be well worth it.


