In the last week of last term Miller Ave School was engaged in the Zero Waste Education programme with Ali.

<u>The new entrants to year 2</u> had fun learning about Litter-Free lunches and enjoyed songs and activities with Ali's 'trash' puppets helping little ones to understand the initial concepts of Zero Waste and how much rubbish can sneak into a lunch box over the weeks. A lot of students had really relevant things to say about rubbish that they already knew.

<u>Years 3-4</u> learned more about Zero Waste through the Reduce unit which explains the basics of the natural resource limitations of our planet. Fun activities, songs and the trash puppets as well as work books are all a part of this unit. A lot of children said they wanted to make puppets and other creations from trash they have at home and said they wanted to make less rubbish.

<u>Years 5-6</u> have done the Recycling unit and have a project for making an informative poster explaining how to recycle properly and the values of this. This poster project may be continued over this term. Students also tried their hand at working in a Recycling Factory and had a lot of fun at the conveyor belt! These students were very engaging and enquiring and took part in singing and other activities to help remember the lessons.

Years 7-8 have completed the Water unit and learned about the importance of looking after our 1% of available fresh water. This unit covered the water cycle, waste water, storm water and water conservation. They have been shown a fairly shocking video of the Citarum River in Indonesia which encouraged a lot of interesting debate afterwards. They also took part in a class activity of adding 'filthy' ingredients to a clean river. This took the shape of a bucket of water and 10 premixed canisters of totally organic but foul looking ingredients, this did raise the 'oooh' factor.

Ali has had a wonderful week with wonderful students and staff.




