CRITERION BRIDGE FLOODGATES OPEN DAY

Come watch Paeroa's brand new flood control gates in action on **Sunday 11th August 2019**.

Waikato Regional Council is holding an open day with road closure at the Criterion Bridge, State Highway 26, from **9am to 11am** to demonstrate how the gates work and talk about why they are so important to protect the community.

The floodgates were installed in August last year and as yet have not been used during a flood event. They were built by Flood Control International, a group in Europe who do flood protection all across the world, and they're the biggest gates they have ever built.

Paeroa residents will have seen the rail along the road, and it's along these that the gates run. When the two gates meet, they get lowered about 30-40 millimetres for a perfect seal.

Before the gates were installed, Waikato Regional Council staff had to construct a Lego type wall to hold back flood waters. The pieces were very heavy and it took 10 to 12 men up to an hour to build the wall between the stopbanks, and it was always touch and go to get it done before the water came through. If we didn't have the stopbanks and floodgates, Paeroa could go three meters under water.

Waikato Regional Council invites Paeroa College/Paeroa Central School/Miller Avenue School/St Joseph's Catholic School/Goldfields School/Paeroa Christian School staff, students and their families along to celebrate this valuable community asset, and show you how quickly we can get them closed.

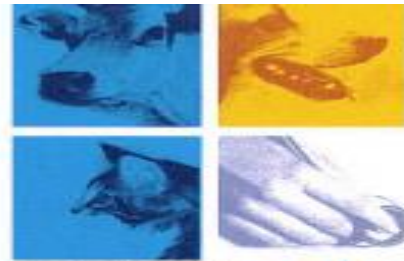
