Kiwi Pie

Ingredients:

- 500g mince
- 1 onion, chopped
- 1 tsp oil
- 1 can baked beans
- 1 can tomatoes
- 2 c frozen mixed veges
- 4 medium potatoes
- 1/4 c low fat milk
- 1/2 c edam cheese, grated
- chopped parsley

Preheat oven to 190°C. Brown onion and mince in pan with oil. Add baked beans, tomatoes and frozen veges, and heat until thawed. Cook potatoes in boiling water until tender, drain well and mash with milk, cheese and chopped parsley. Spoon mixture into individual dishes or a large pie dish and top with mashed potato. Bake for 25mins until golden.

Ingredients:

- 500 gms o te miiti
- 1 te aniana
- 1 tsp o te hinu
- kia kotahi te keene peeke piini
- kia kotahi te keene tomato
- 2 c o ngaa huawhenua
- rerekee, kua maaota
- 4 ngaa riwai wawaenga
- 1/4 c o te miraka ngako iti
- 1/2 c o te tihi erama, kua waruwarutia
- He parihi, kua haaua

Whakamahanatia te umu ki te 190°C. Aata tunu te aniana me te miiti ki te hinu ki roto i te kohua. Taapirihia te peeke piini, te tomato me ngaa hua whenua maaota, aa, whakamahanatia kia koero ai. Tunu ngaa riwai ki roto i te wai koropupuu kia taangohengohe rawa, whakamimitihia, aa, penupenu ki te miraka, te tihi me te paarihi. Rawa te ranunga ki roto i la rihi kia takitahi ai, ki roto i teetahi takakau miiti nui raanei, rawa he riwai penupenu ki runga i te takakau miiti. Kia rua takau meeneti te waa tunu, kia koorua mai te aahua.
