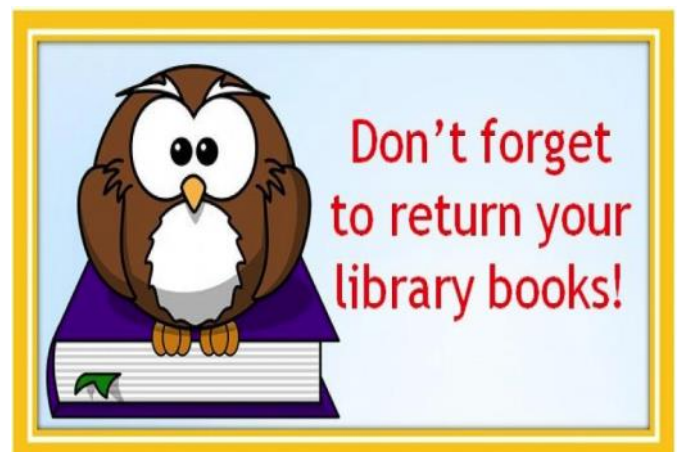

LITTLE ATHLETICS—YEAR 1 & 2

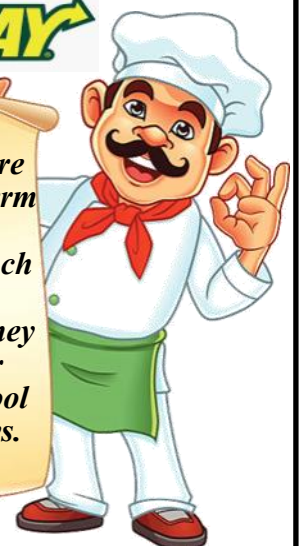
