GLOBAL FLAVOURS

CHINESE SWEET & SOUR PORK

Ingredients:

- 1/2 Tbsp oil
- 350g lean pork, diced
- 1 red capsicum, chopped
- 1 onion, finely chopped
- 1 carrot, sliced
- 1 can pineapple pieces in juice, drained

- 1/2 c pineapple juice
- 1 tsp ginger, grated
- 1 Tbsp soy sauce
- 1 1/2 Tbsp white vinegar
- 1 1/2 Tbsp tomato sauce
- 1 tsp brown sugar
- 1 Tbsp cornflour
- 2 Tbsp cold water

Heat oil in pan over high heat. Add pork. Stir-fry until lightly browned. Add veges. Stir-fry for 5mins. Add ginger, juice, soy sauce, vinegar, tomato sauce and sugar. Simmer until veges are just cooked. Dissolve cornflour in water, add to pan along with pineapple pieces and stir until sauce thickens. Serve with rice.

Ingredients:

- 1/2 Tbsp o te hinu
- 350g te miti hinuiti kua tapahia
- 1 rapikama whero, kua hahautia
- 1 te aniana, kua hahautia rawa
- 1 te kaaroti kua kooripitia
- 1 te keene maramara painaaporo
- ki roto i ngaa wai, kua whakamimitiia

- 1/2 c te wai o te painaaporo
- 1 Tbsp o te tinitia, kua waruaurutia
- 1 Tbsp o te wairanu soy
- 1 1/2 Tbsp o te winika maa
- 1 Tbsp o te wairanu tomato
- 1 Tbsp o te huka paraone
- 1 Tbsp o te paura kanga
- 2 Tbsp o te wai makariri Maori

Whakamahanatia te hinu ki te paa mahanatanga teitei. Taapirihia te miti hinu. Parai Kauroritia kia aahua paraone te tae. Taapirihia ngaa hua whenua. Parai Kauroritia moo te rima meeneti. Taapirihia te tinitia, te wai painaaporo, te wairanu soy, te winika, te wairanu tomato me te huka. Aata tunu kia rite ngaa hua whenua. Whakarewatia te paura kanga ki te wai, taapiri atu ki te kooehua, anoo nei ngaa maramara painaaporo, aa, kororitia kia kukuu ai. Tukua atu, he raihi hoki hei taapiri.
