Kia Ora Koutou, Nga mihi

We as a school have been following closely the advice coming from the Ministry of Education and the Ministry of Health in response to the challenges posed by the Corona Virus, Covid 19. Along with the increased vigilance around personal hygiene practices staff have been monitoring students health and wellbeing and providing advice and reassurance to families based on notifications received from the Ministry.

The Ohinemuri Swimming Sports was cancelled this week in order to minimise social contact in a large group situation and in line with this Beach Day has also been cancelled. School assemblies have been put on hold for the foreseeable future and parents/caregivers are asked to keep sick children at home, particularly if your child has cold or flu like symptoms or a cough. Should a child develop any of these symptoms while at school the child will be isolated and the family called to arrange for the child to be collected.

We have increased our cleaning regime to ensure contact surfaces are being regularly cleaned and sanitised. Students are encouraged to bring personal water bottles to eliminate the transfer of saliva at communal drinking fountains. Our school drinking fountains will be turned off tomorrow (Friday).

If you have family members returning or recently returned from overseas and close contact has been made with them please keep your child/children home for 14 days from the date of contact. Please be vigilant in this in order to keep all of our children safe.

Our staff are working hard to provide stability and as much normalcy as possible for our children while at school. We will continue to provide the best level of care possible in order to keep our tamariki safe.

Absenteeism If your child is going to be away from school please notify the office with the reason for their absence so we can keep track of all of our students and any health concerns they may have.






