Our nation is now in Alert Level 2 – Reduce Contact (Level 3 for the Auckland Region – Restrict Contact). While it is natural for us to be concerned, and have questions at this time, it is important as adults we reassure our children, be resilient, sensible and prepared. As a school we have implemented the same Alert Level 2 guidelines and procedures we used earlier in the year and we will update you as further information comes to hand.

A few notes for our parents/caregivers about school under Alert Level 2:

- We are still open, school is considered a safe place for children to be and students are encouraged to attend school. If you are keeping your children home please let us know by calling the school office.
- We need to limit the amount of contact external adults and children have in our school and be able to track and trace if required. We have cancelled a number of visits and gatherings and will not be having school assemblies during Alert Level 2. Please ensure you avoid unnecessary visits/prolonged contact and be very aware of safe hygienic practices. Please this is about our students and staff being safe and nothing else.
- All visitors to the school (including parents) must sign in at the office or use the Covid Tracer App Code located on the office door and desk.

Registration - \$10.00 pp/dance. Maximum \$60.00 pp all up for one day, or \$100.00 pp all up for <u>two</u> days.

Audience tickets each day - \$10.00 pp for the competition (up to 4.30 pm); \$15.00 pp for the Showcase (from 5.00).

Dance time: Solos - 1 min; Others - 1.5 min Grace period 5 sec.
