HEADLICE

These little critters are out and about at our school. Please check your child's hair regularly and treat as necessary as we need to keep on top of them, especially to help those families that are trying hard to rid headlice from their child's hair.

Anyone can get head lice it doesn't matter how clean or dirty a person's hair is. Head lice spread by crawling from one person's hair to another's – usually between people who are in close contact, such as school classmates. Please check for head lice often, at least once a week. Scratching, scratch marks or a rash can be a sign that your child has head lice.

Chemical treatments or wet combing are the usual ways to treat head lice. Ordinary shampoo or soap will not kill head lice. Do not use fly spray, kerosene or animal treatments, as these may harm children.

We do have combs available at school and by going to your child's doctor they will prescribe free head lice treatment.

A child with live lice should stay away from school until treatment has started.
