Year - 7 and 8 disco Friday November 5th 6pm – 8pm Jubilee Hall.

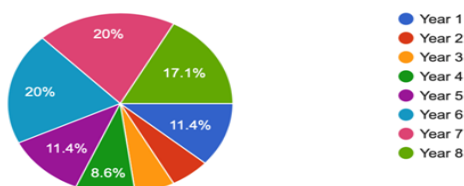
Halloween theme. \$3.00 per person. Permission slips will come home on **Friday 29th October**

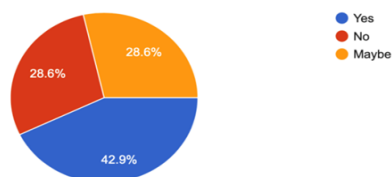
Which MAS year group/s are your tamariki in?
