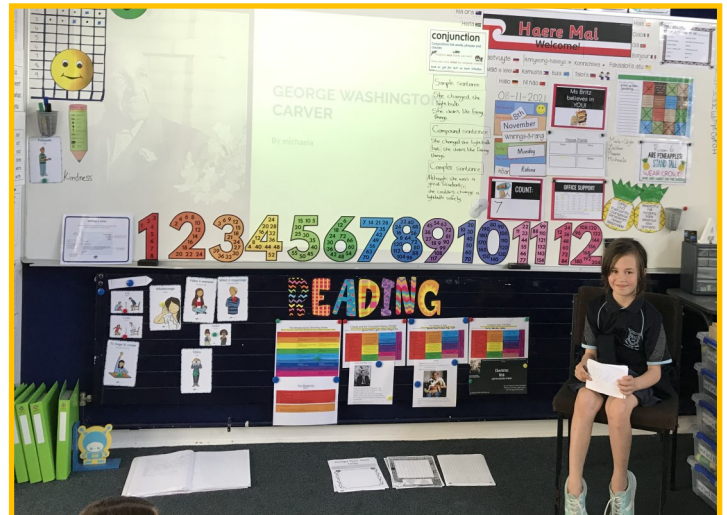


## Room 6 - Team Work Makes The Dream Work

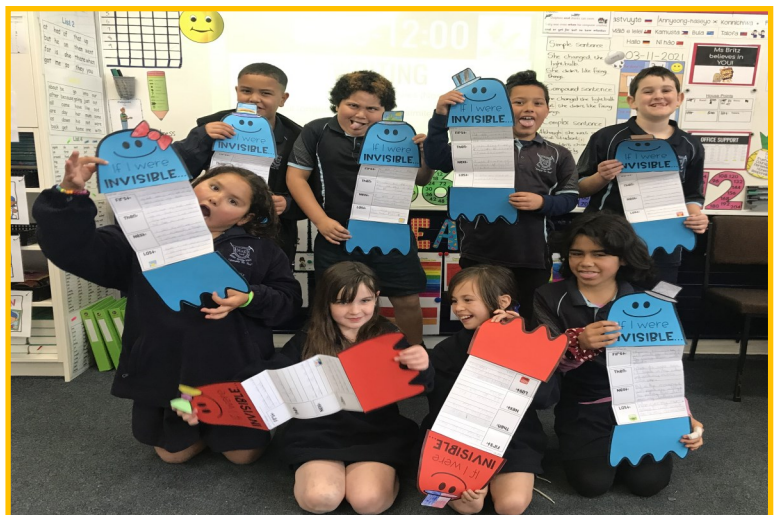

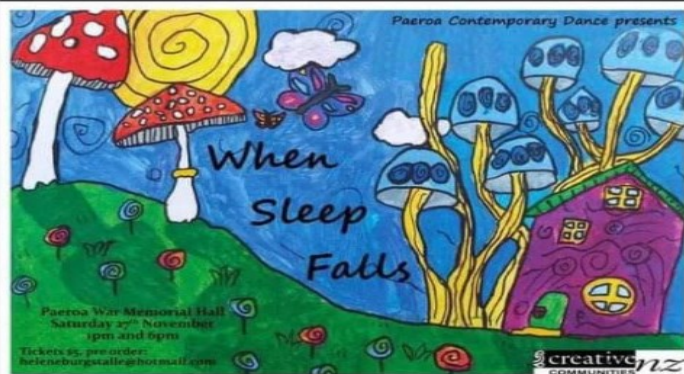
