Room 9— Amazing Ancient Egypt

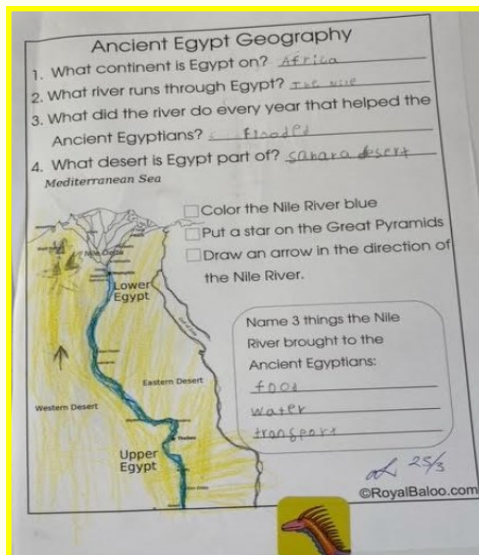
Room 9 have travelled back to the time of the Ancient Egyptians!
