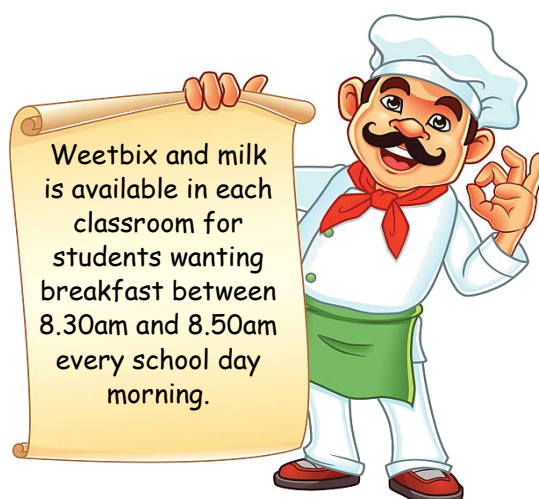

Room 7 (Ruma Waipuna-ā-rangi)

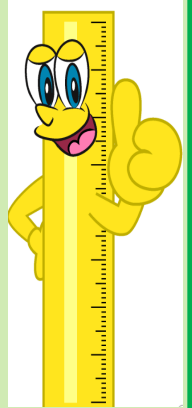
Learns Measurement

Room 7 (Waipuna-ā-rangi) is learning about the measurement strand in maths this term.

We have practiced using personal benchmarks (feet, hands and fingers) to measure objects in the classroom and around the school.

Next we made our own paper planes following instructions from a youtube video. The next day we flew the planes in the hall and measured how far they flew. Summer's plane flew the furthest at 6.5 metres!

Our next measurement activities will be learning about time— recognising the length of a second and a minute and telling the time to the half hour and hour.

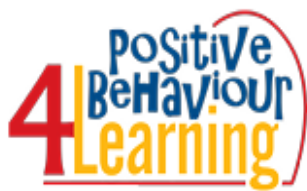

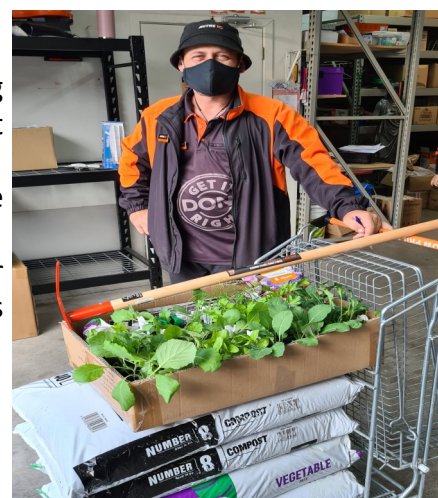
