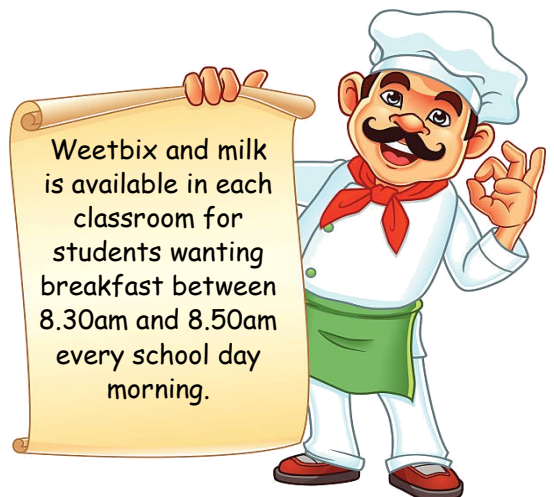

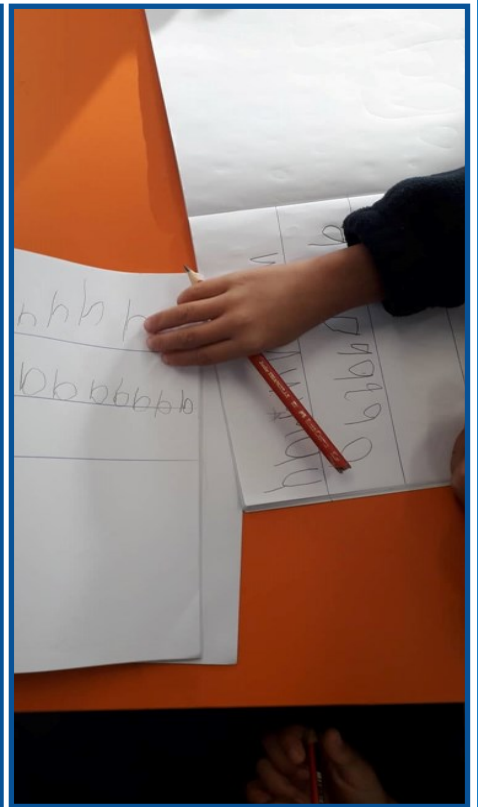
A Busy Term 2 in Ruma Waiti (Room 8)
