We are really pleased to announce that **20** students received these awards for term one. This is a new initiative to acknowledge those tamariki who are really trying hard to be at school everyday.


This term we would like to improve on that number.

Thank you to our special visitor who did the 'last post' for us, ano te pai Mr Brett Lowe.


Many thanks to Whaea Liz for organisation of this special event and for organising the MAS students participation in the ANZAC civil parade on Tuesday morning.




