We look forward to another great term - we have some great learning opportunities lined up, watch out for the class newsletters that will go out in the first week of Term 3.

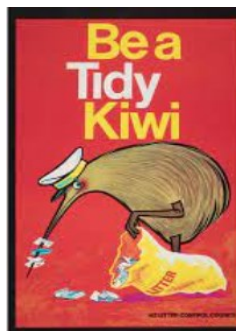
