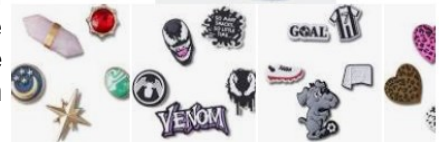

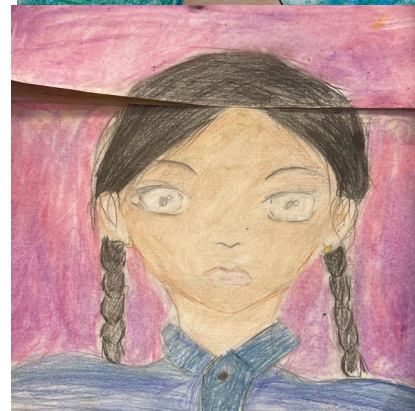

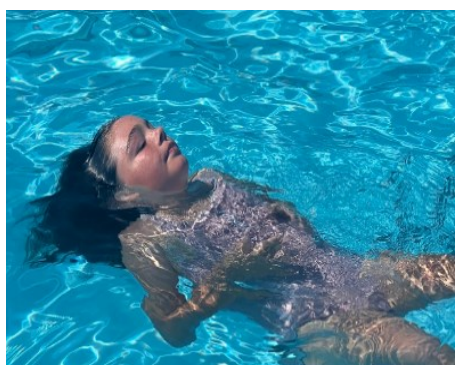


## KIA ORA FROM WAITI

Our house points competition will continue and we welcome whanau to join us for our sharing assemblies at 2pm on a Friday

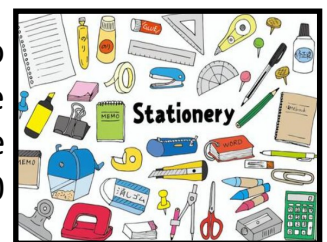
