## SPORT SNACK IDEA

1-2 balls = 1 serving  
Recipe makes 12-15 balls

### Bliss Ball recipe

- 1 1/2 cups pitted dates
- 1/4 cup sunflower seeds
- 2 tbsp canola oil
- 2 tbsp cocoa powder
- 1 tsp vanilla extract
- 1/2 cup (45g) desiccated coconut, for rolling

- Place all the ingredients, apart from the coconut, into a food processor and whizz for 45 seconds.
- Remove mixture from processor and empty into a bowl.
- Scoop up handfuls of the mix, and roll into small balls. Then roll each ball through the coconut.
- Serve immediately or store in an airtight container in the fridge for up to 10 days.
