THAMES VALLEY CROSS COUNTRY


Well done to all of our students who competed in the Thames Valley Cross Country last Thursday. The track was very muddy and slippery and all the students ran extremely well.




Room 6—Recalling Facts

Deacon and Havik from Room 6 have illustrated and recalled facts of what they learnt about Whitebait.



- · Are usually 25-50 mm long
- These small native fish species are edible.
- Often travel together in schools along coasts, in estuaries and up rivers.
- After about 6 months at sea floating as part of the oceans plankton mass – they return to the rivers and move upstream to live in freshwater, and they grow into adults.

- Whitebait is a term used for a number of small native fish species that are edible.
- They are usually 25–50 mm long and often travel together in schools along coasts, in estuaries and up rivers
- The eggs are laid during spring tides in autumn on the banks of the river in vegetation flooded by the tide, near estuaries.
- After about 6 months at sea they return to the rivers and move upstream to live in freshwater, and they grow into adults.
- The adults swim back down the river to spawn.


