Sunhats are compulsory throughout term 4. Our school sunhats can be purchased from Direct Group by placing an order through our school office or their online store.

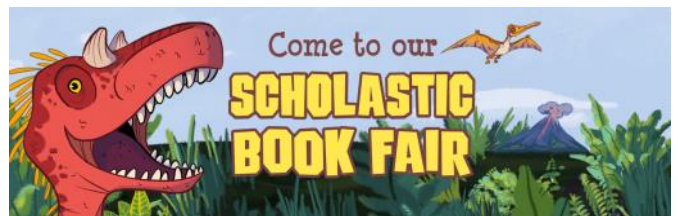


KAPA HAKA FESTIVAL
