Nga mihi ki a koutou nga Kaiako, Kaimahi o te kura.





DONATIONS SCHEME You may have heard late last year the Ministry of Education offered decile 1-7 schools funding of \$150 per student for 2020 in lieu of schools asking for school donations.

The offer was accepted by the Board of Trustees knowing that asking for a school donation and payment for school trips can often cause financial stress for families and households. We have also had a number of enquiries from families asking if they can still make a donation. The answer is "yes" you can still donate and contribute to trips and we very much appreciate any donations we receive, but it is not an obligation.

By opting into the Donation Scheme you will not be required to pay for curriculum related day trips. However based on how much funding we receive per child we may need to re-evaluate what trips we do each year.

The funding does not cover fees associated with playing for sports teams that take place as an extra curricular activity e.g. netball, touch rugby. It also does not cover over night camps, so contribution towards the cost of those would still be appreciated.


