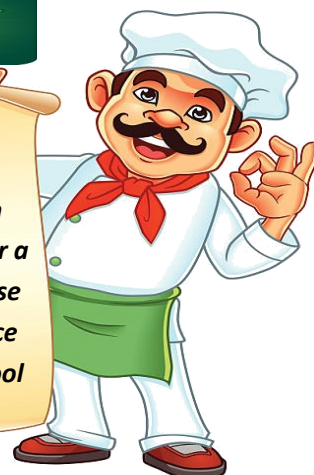

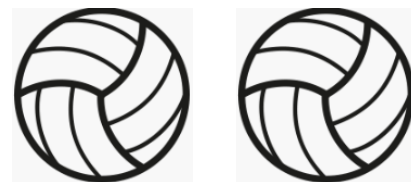
### TEACHER ONLY DAY
