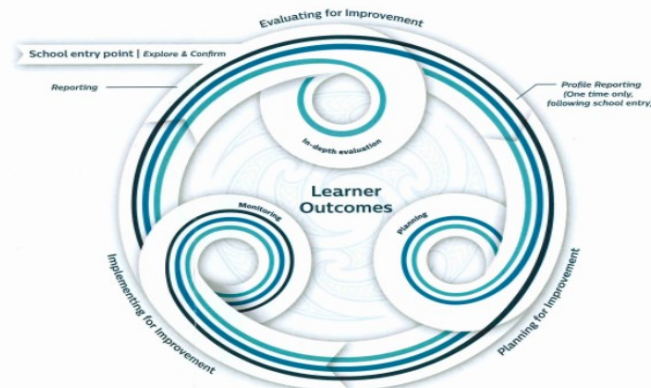
Another busy week at MAS.

#### Welcome to this week's PB4L message:

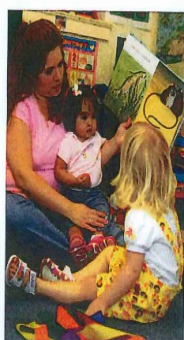
