Enviro Schools **Bronze** Reflection

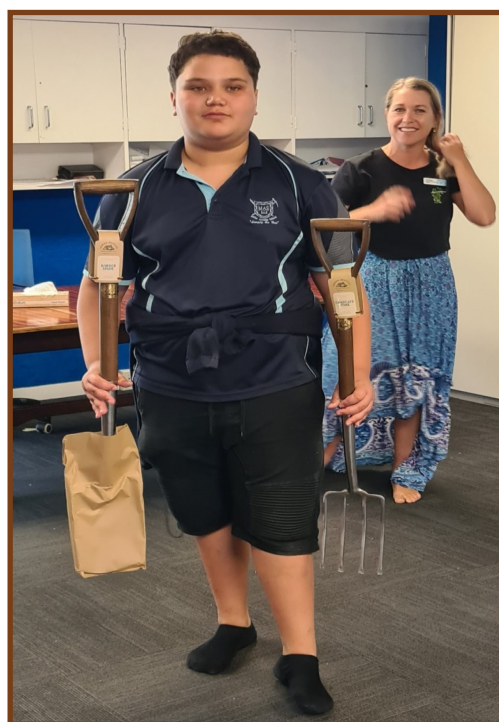
Bronze reflection day yesterday was a celebration for our school, receiving our Bronze certificate from Enviro Schools.

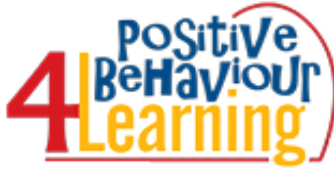
